

## THE IMMEDIATE ALTERNATIVE! THE OBVIOUS CHOICE!

 Does not constrain flow. In high volume situations, more of the incoming water will pass by the filter but flow is not impeded.

 When flow (rain) seizes, the filter continues to work. Storm water is continuously purified.

- Does not require mounting or service. Swedrop is simply lowered into the drain and a simple water guide is placed under the manhole cover (supplied with each filter).
- After use, the whole filter is retrieved and sent to incineration. No maintenance work at the drain is required.
- Very low cost of labor. If the filter is exchanged in conjunction to the periodic sludge removal, the marginal effort is minimal.
