



## THE IMMEDIATE ALTERNATIVE! THE OBVIOUS CHOICE!

- Does not constrain flow. In high volume situations, more of the incoming water will pass by the filter but flow is not impeded.
- When flow (rain) ceases, the filter continues to work. Storm water is continuously purified.
- Does not require mounting or service. Swedrop is simply lowered into the drain and a simple water guide is placed under the manhole cover (supplied with each filter).
- After use, the whole filter is retrieved and sent to incineration. No maintenance work at the drain is required.
- Very low cost of labor. If the filter is exchanged in conjunction to the periodic sludge removal, the marginal effort is minimal.
